All proceeds from the event support "Heart of Springs" to raise much-needed funds for preservation and improvements of notable historic icons in the hamlet including Ashawagh Hall, Springs Community Church and Springs Library.

The "Fisherman Formal" *Heart of Springs Gala Benefit* will feature live music from Michael Pour and Tom Bono, sumptuous local fare from our local farms and sea, fine wines and local craft beers.
